

Second Annual Kansas Private Land Fundraising Hunt!!!

This 4-person hunt is for the advanced, experienced hunters, and their dogs, that want a challenge. The hunt will be on premier (the top 10%) hunting ground in and around Ellis County (Hays) Kansas. Birds, both pheasant and quail, abound and are sophisticated giving hunters an unequaled hunting experience. Our hosts and partners, PF Chapter 424, search out and secure prime bird locations for us to hunt on.

Where would we stay?

Our hosts own a farmstead and have converted the buildings into a comfortable, bunk style, lodge for sleeping and dining. They prepare a field lunch and dinner, escort us from field to field, taking awesome care of us. The environment is a beautiful, Kansas country setting.

When?

Hunters will arrive on Thursday Jan 4, 2024, and leave on Sunday, Jan 7, 2024, with the hunt covering Friday and Saturday (5th & 6th).

Value:

This is not a typical bird farm hunt. It is an experience in advanced hunting. A value of \$1500/person (includes hunt, lodging, lunch & dinner, and access) or \$6000 for team of 4.

Hunters are expected to be experienced with hunting safely under a variety of conditions including blocking, covey rises, etc. All hunters are responsible for their own, and others, safety. A minimum of 2 dogs is essential, 3 is suggested.

Included in the hunt:

Access to more acres than anyone can hunt in 2 days.

Lodging in a bunk style (1 room) building converted into a lodge (not fancy) but it is fully equipped.

A field lunch and simple dinner will be provided.

Dogs/kennels allowed in lodge.

Not included in the hunt:

Hunting licenses, dogs, shells (this is not an outfitters hunt).

Breakfast or snacks, fridges are on site so food can be stored as needed.

Drinks, water, personal items

Transportation.

Motels nearby if preferred
