Greetings,

As the South Metro Denver Pheasants Forever Chapter President, I would like to welcome all of you to our annual fundraising banquet. We have a passionate group of volunteers that have worked hard to put this evening together in support of our mission. The South Metro Chapter's conservation commitment is twofold; Outreach and Education for youth/women/novice hunters and wildlife habitat protection and enhancement.

Outreach and Education - Our Outreach programs support education for youth, women, and novice hunters as we strive to help educate and develop future conservationists. We are fortunate to have a strong relationship with Colorado Parks and Wildlife committed to the development and delivery of these programs. Many of our programs are conducted at Barr Lake and Cherry Creek State Parks. Our Chapter supports Youth Outdoor Activity Day, Ladies Events, and we partner with other groups and PF chapters to assist in youth outreach around the state. Colorado PF has six Youth Outreach Trailers that we have helped fully equip to host outdoor events. Through last year, Colorado PF reached well over 10,000 youth in CO.

Wildlife Habitat - We are also passionate about establishing great habitat in Eastern CO for Pheasants, Quail and a variety of wildlife including pollinators. SMPF PF has helped fund Colorado Farm Bill Biologist (FBB) positions. The Colorado PF FBB program is a joint effort between PF, Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW), Muley Fanatic Foundation (MFF) and The Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). Since its inception, this support has resulted in the creation and enhancement of over 1.2 million acres of upland wildlife habitat in eastern Colorado; primarily affecting acres enrolled in The Farm Bill's Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). In addition, this chapter has been a major contributor to the "Corners for Conservation" program in eastern Colorado. This program has resulted in over 300 pivot corners of habitat that are also enrolled into CPW's hunter walk in program. We also helped purchase three high quality, no-till habitat project seed drills for eastern Colorado.

Pheasants Forever has created a unique model allowing all funds raised at tonight's banquet to stay with the local chapter. This ensures that the money you donate tonight is spent on our local outreach programs and other worthwhile programs that improve pheasant and wildlife habitat in Colorado. The bottom line is we get to decide where the money goes. We have earned a good rating from Charity Navigator, recognizing that you can give with confidence to our organization.

I am extremely proud of the team of dedicated PF members that give their time as volunteers to organize and staff the events that we hold throughout the year. Please take the time to thank those PF members in attendance for all their contributions and hard work. Without them, we would not have the funds and peoplepower to provide the opportunities that we are currently able to.

Our accomplishments, past, present, and future would not be possible without the support of Sponsors, Donors, and banquet-goers such as YOU. 4. Dakota Hot Spots Pheasant Hunt for Two - Dakota Hot Spots in Lyman County South Dakota is a family operated business on 1200 acres. The package is for 2 hunters for 2 days of pheasant hunting. You will hunt private ground including corn, milo, sorghum, shelter belts, soughs, and CRP. Lodging and 3 hot meals per day are included. There is a 3-bird limit per hunter per day. Extra hunters (up to 6) may be added for \$650 per day. Extra birds require an upgraded package, please contact the lodge. Other upgrades can include prairie chickens, sharp tail grouse and walleye fishing. You may fly into Sioux Falls, Pierre, Chamberlain, or Rapid City. Season dates are Sept. 1 to March 31.

6. Hartsel Ranch Trophy Fly Fishing Accommodations- The Hartsel Ranch is providing two nights of luxury accommodations at the confluence of the South Fork and Middle Fork of the South Platte River. A cabin includes 2 king sized beds, kitchen, living room and full bath. Includes continental breakfasts. It is close to Spinney Mountain Reservoir. You may make use of nearby public access for fly fishing or, at your additional cost, hire a guide through Hayden Roe of Mountain Angler Guide Services to fish 2 miles of private river. Their cabin accommodations can host 3 or 4

- guests. The booking is limited to 2 nights between Sunday and Thursday. You can upgrade this package. This is a trophy fishing opportunity.
- 7. Colorado Upland Hunt for Four The Bluffs is Colorado's Finest Wingshooting Lodge. Near Byers, Co., the Bluffs has a line of clay bluffs overlooking the treestudded confluence of Bijou Creeks. This hunt is a ½ day hunt for 4 hunters, with a 16-bird limit for the group. Bring your own bird dogs. Pheasants, chukar, and bobwhite quail are the quarry. This hunt is not guided. A hearty breakfast and lunch are included.

Bearpoint Kennel Puppy-** We have another stellar puppy coming to us from an amazing pair: 4X-GMPR- TC HRCH Bud's High Plains Deacon MH and APR Bearpoint's Gem of Jewels (Daughter of 4X-GMPR SHR Bearpoint's Triple Threat Excalibur MH). This litter is going to have a great personality and INCREDIBLE natural hunting and pointing abilities. You won't want to miss out on this epic breeding from Bearpoint Kennel. - 10. Wild Pheasant Hunt with South Dakota Outfitters Unlimited This is a wild bird hunt on over 30,000 acres in south central South Dakota for SIX HUNTERS. Hunt milo fields, native grasslands, small food plots, CRP and many shelter belts near Geddes, S.D. Two days of hunting and three nights in our beautiful lodge. Meals are included. Guides and dogs are provided. Transportation to fields is provided. You can bring your own dog/s. Bird cleaning and packaging is included. Hunters have to purchase S.D. licenses. You can upgrade this hunt to include additional hunters for \$2,375 each. The winning bidder can add walleye fishing to the trip for an additional fee by contacting the Lodge. Gun rentals are available at current rates. 2024 DATES STILL AVAILABLE: Nov. 11-24, Dec. 9-11, Dec. 16-22 and 2025 Jan. 5-21.

12. Walleye Fishing Trip for 2 Anglers with Dakota Prairie Guide ServiceThis trip is back by popular demand! Walleye fishing in the Missouri River and surrounding reservoirs including Lake Francis Case, Lake Sharpe and Lake Oahe. This is a 3-night, 2-day guided walleye trip near Chamberlain, S.D. with Dakota Prairie Guide Service. This package includes rooms at the local Best Western. First-rate boats and transportation to the water are provided. You can upgrade this trip for up to 2 additional anglers for \$300 each. Book it for spring or summer. You must take the trip this year (2024). Anglers must buy S.D. licenses.


- 13. Smoky River Rendezvous Upland Hunt for 4 in Kansas- This a 4-hunter trip with 2 days hunting and lodging. The Smoky River Lodge in Winona, Kansas has an interesting history. The building was built in 1886 as a city restaurant and in 1920 lodging rooms were added. The current owners bought it in 1995 and converted it to a hunting lodge. There are over 4,000 acres of hunting ground including stubble ground, CRP and natural habitat. Pheasants, chukar and quail are offered. The package includes lodging, pro shop, meals, guides, game processing and kenneling for hunting dogs. A Kansas hunting license or controlled shooting license is required depending on your hunting preference. Both are available to purchase at the Lodge. Bird limits vary depending on wild bird or controlled shooting choices. Upgrades are available, and an additional hunter is \$650 per day. Winona is just a 3-hour drive from Denver. You will want to go back again and again.
- 14. South Dakota Hidden Hill Lodge Pheasant Hunt for Four- Four pheasant hunters will hunt for 2 days and enjoy 3 nights lodging at Hidden Hill Lodge near Roslyn, S.D. Their motto is "Let Us Treat You Like Family". Besides the hunting, meals include hot and hearty breakfasts, field snacks and gourmet dinners which include, but are not limited to, steak and lobster, prime rib, BBQ St Louis ribs, walleye, and 18 oz ribeyes... the food alone should get you out there! The package also includes a Movie Memory of your hunt, S.D. licenses included, birds cleaned and vacuum packed, hot tub, fire pit, guides & dogs, game room, client dogs kenneled in their boxes in a heated/air-conditioned garage, trap and hunting ammo, rifle and pistol range. There is free airport pickup from either Abereen S.D. or Fargo, N.D. You can upgrade your trip: additional hunters at \$2299 each, trophy Walleye fishing \$250/day/person (\$500 minimum).
- 15. Colorado Fly Fishing Float Trip for Two- Two anglers will enjoy a full day float trip guided by Fish On Colorado. Spend the day fly fishing while you float down one of the great rivers in Colorado. During your guided fly fishing trip, you will target wild rainbows, brown and cutthroat trout. The rivers we float are: Upper Colorado, Roaring Fork, Eagle, and Lower Colorado. Trip must be booked in advance during the 2024 season (good now until Thanksgiving). Fish On Colorado was started to provide more people with the experience of being out in nature, in some of the most beautiful places in Colorado while enjoying a tug on the other end of a fly line. Don't miss out on this home state opportunity!


